# Ever- Snowing Ornament



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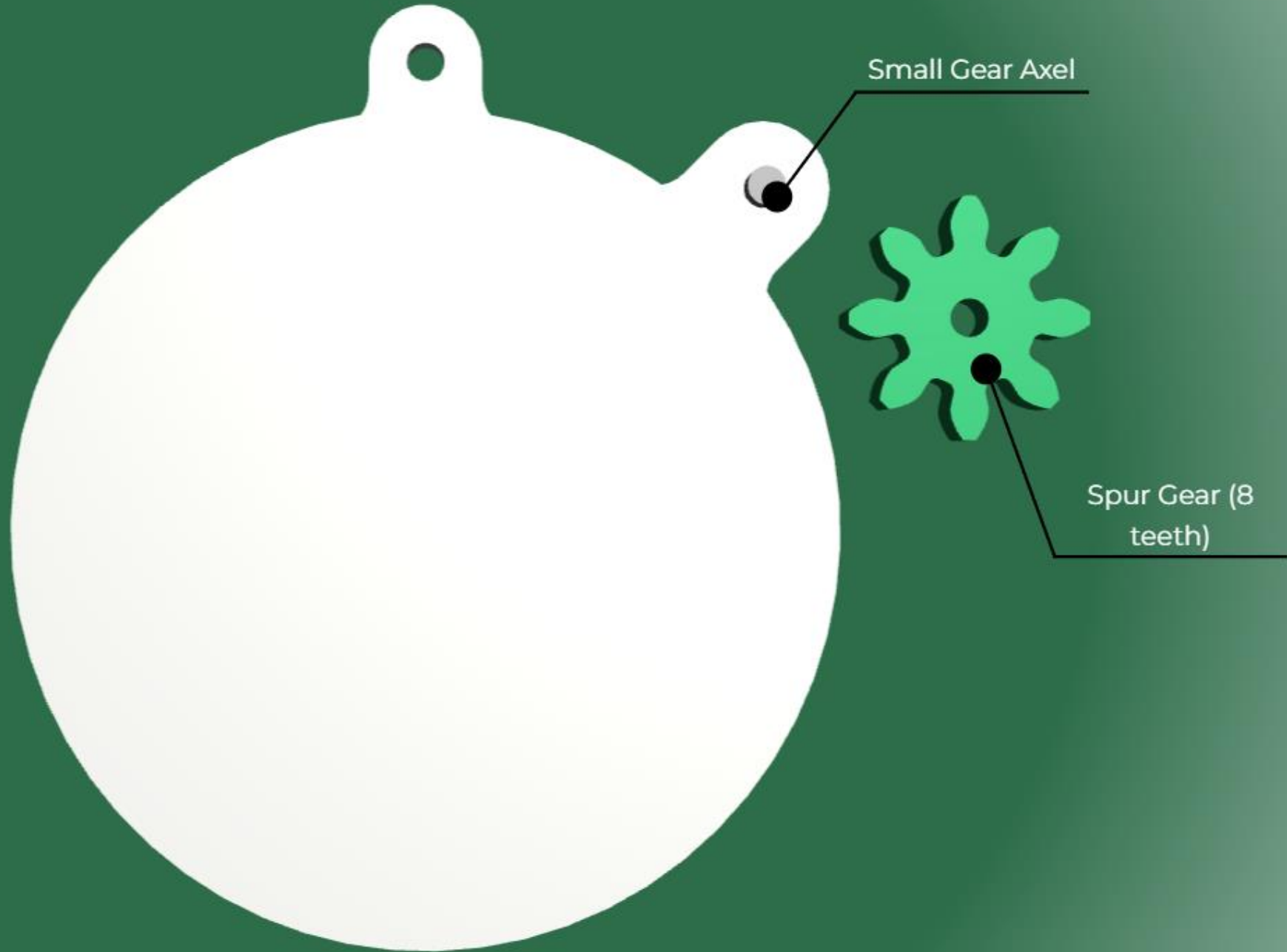
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Start by gluing on the Small Gear Axel.

DONT REMOVE THE MASKING ON THE AXEL. The masking will help to keep the back and the front separated enough for the snow to fall through.

Use the Small Spur Gear to align the Axel. The gear should be concentric with the round tap that Axel rests on.



Wait for the glue to dry on the Axel and then place the spur Gear on it.

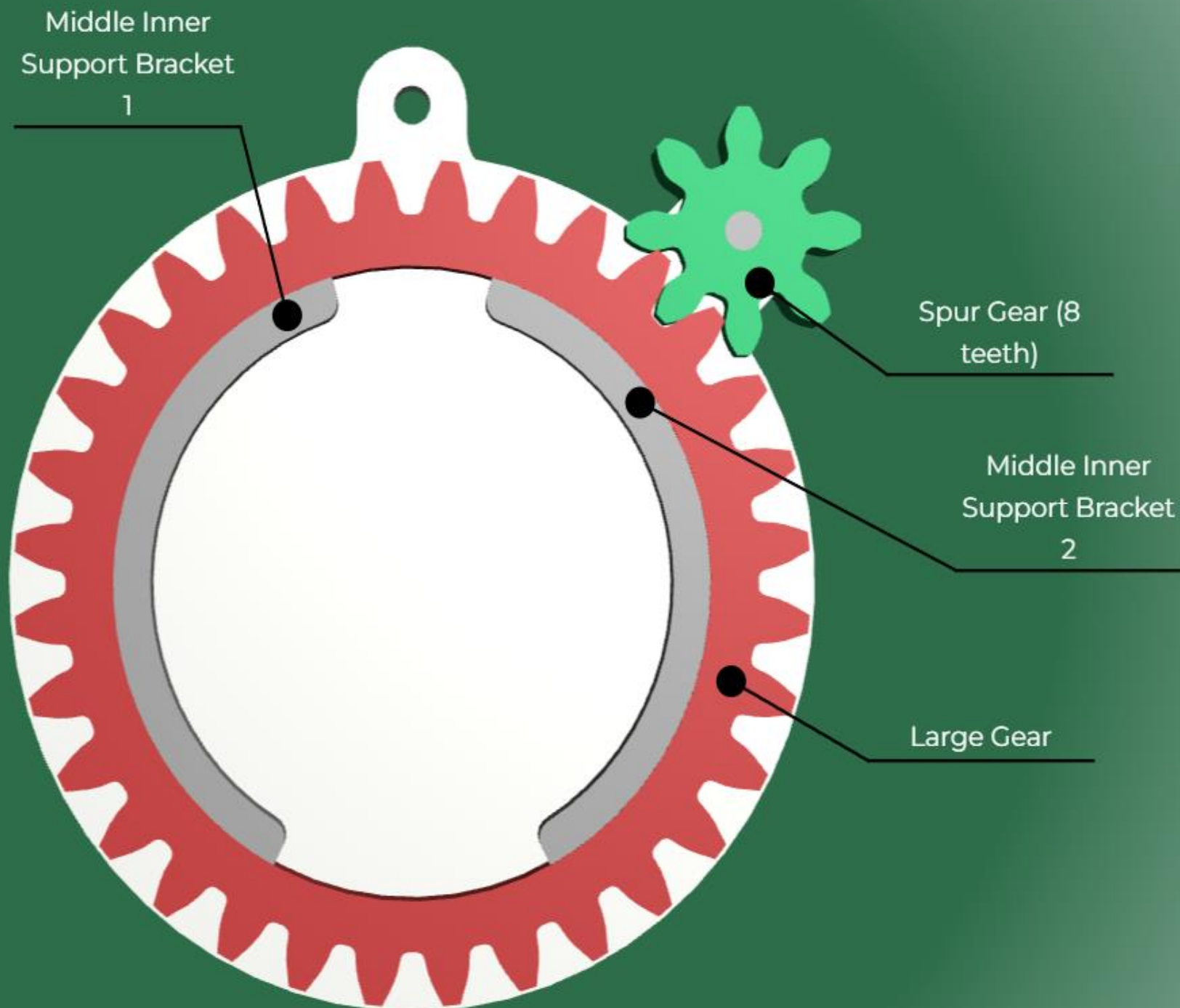


Next, glue the Middle Inner Support Brackets.

DONT REMOVE THE MASKING ON THE BRACKETS. The masking will help to keep the back and the front separated enough for the snow to fall through.

Note: While these look like they are attached to the Large Gear, there should be a very small amount of space between them. The same is true for the teeth of the spur gear.

Before gluing, or allowing glue to dry, make sure the small gear spins and spins the large gear. If it doesn't, the gears may be too close together or the Inner Brackets may be too close to the Large Gear.





Glue the tree (or whatever decoration you decide to put in) to the Back. The masking can be remove on this.

Next, glue on the Front Cover.

Do this by adding a small amount of glue to the masking on top of the Middle Inner Support Brackets and the Small Gear Axel.

Then place the Top Cover on and align it with the back.

There will be a risk of glue getting on the gears and sticking so, as the glue dries, spin the gears to prevent them from getting stuck.

This is roughly what it looks like.

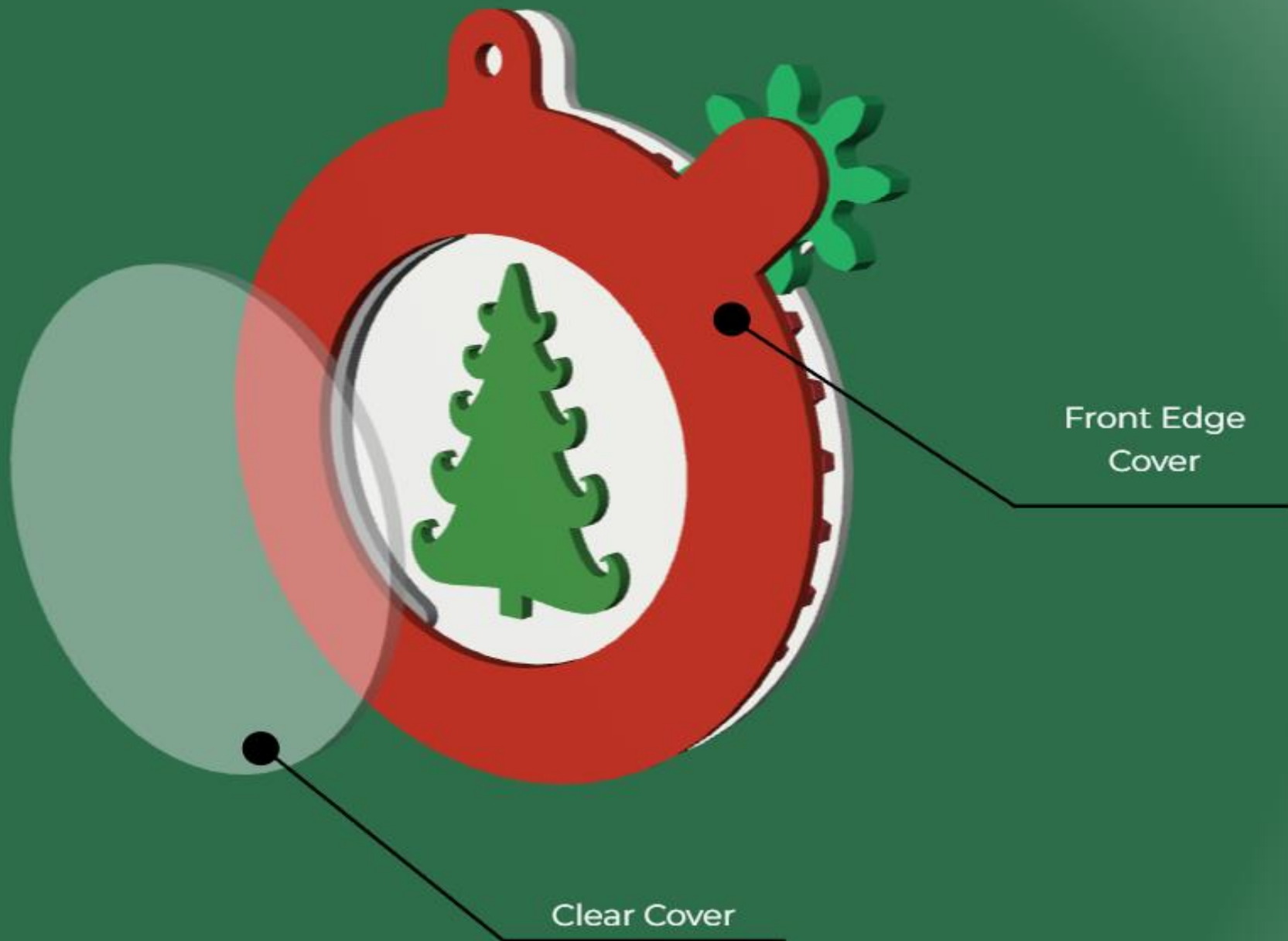


Front Edge

Make sure the gears spin and add in 8-16 snowflakes. Make sure they sit flat.

The glue in the Clear Cover.

Originally I glued this to the Tree but the glue marks were visible and didn't look great. I would suggest instead to add a drop of glue in various places on the edge of the Clear Cover to it adheres to the Front Edge Cover.
